



Sunshine Bay Yacht Club & Edmonton Yacht Club Race Notice



Spring Series - 2018 June 09, 10, 16 & 17 2018

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the *Sail Canada Prescriptions 2017 - 2020*.

2. Eligibility

The Regatta is open to all sailors who hold a valid membership of *Sail Canada* or an *ASA affiliated club*.

3. Fees

\$40.00 per boat for full regatta or \$10.00 per day per boat if not able to compete in all races. All fees are payable by cash or cheque to Sunshine Bay Yacht Club. No credit or debit payments will be accepted.

4. Awards

Awards will be presented to 1st 2nd and 3rd place finishers

5. Schedule

Registration: Prior to 09:30 on race day. See attached *Registration Form*.

Skippers Meeting: 09:30 on first day of racing. Sailing Instructions will be available.

Start of first race each day: 11:00

Number of races scheduled: eight (8). Two (2) races each day are scheduled.

6. Course

The diagrams in the attachment show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate total course length is 5 nautical miles. The course to be used will be decided at the skippers meeting.

7. Classes

Handicaps of 210 and higher - *Red Fleet*

Handicaps of 209 and lower - *Blue Fleet*

Fleet minimum is 5 boats. If there are less than 5 boats for each fleet all boats will race in one fleet.

8. Scoring

One race constitutes a series

When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When 5 – 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's score is the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9. Radio Communications

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

The Race Officer may communicate with the race fleet on channel 72.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

11. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000.00 per incident or the equivalent.

12. Rights to Use Name and Likeness

In participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants the *Organizing Authority* and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use or show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
