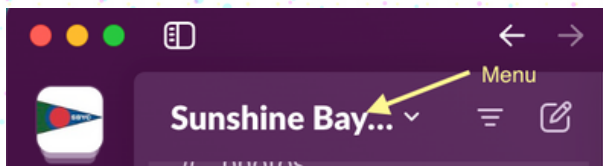

Slack is our Club Member-to-Member communication platform. Some tips to keep the conversation flowing!

- Install the app on your mobile device in order to get push notifications.
- You can control the notifications that you get (all, only @mentions or none) for each channel or the whole application by going to the Menu (click on “Sunshine Bay” in the top left corner, and then go to Preferences. You can set the hours allowed for notifications, and settings for each channel.



- In a channel, you can “mention” someone (send a notification directly to them about a message by putting an @ symbol in front of their name with no space between @ and FirstName. For example @FirstName LastName. The name will appear as a link.
- To notify a whole channel, you can type “@channel” when posting in a particular channel

Starlink and Cameras

Starlink internet has been purchased and installed at the clubhouse. The intent of this was to install monitoring equipment for the security and maintenance of clubhouse assets. However, once the board has installed some additional equipment, they will be making WiFi internet available to members.

The four cameras that are installed are:

- road to green shack;
- view of both docks;
- basement crawl space;
- locked office room;

The cameras allow for remote monitoring of these spaces by Facilities Director Lee. See next page for a view of what the cameras can see.

LOOKING AHEAD AT PIRATE DAYS!

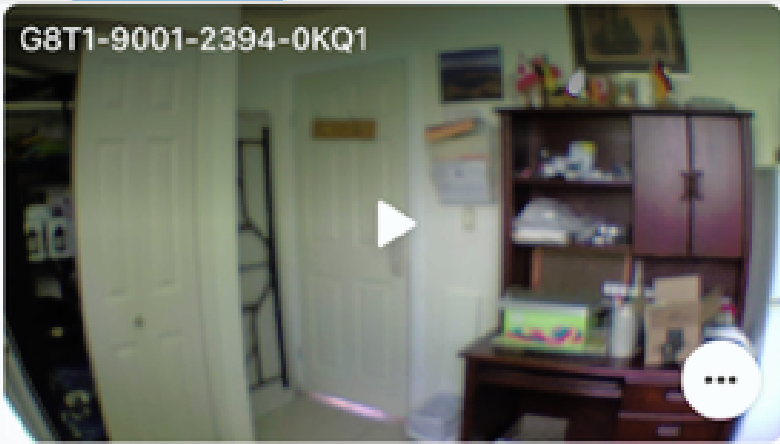
Pirate Days will be here before you know it on August Long Weekend!
